

Woodward Township Supervisors Workshop

April 1, 2026

The Woodward Township Supervisors' workshop meeting was called to order at 6 pm. by Mr. Jeff Stroehamnn, with the following in attendance: Craig Grove, Wayne Robinson, Joe Lyons and Pamela Musser, later attending Vic Marquardt from Code Inspections.

There was some discussion regarding the campground ordinance, this will be placed on the agenda for next week's meeting.

The code assessment proposal was then discussed; this will be placed on the agenda for next week's meeting. There was a discussion regarding the office space available and the monthly rent.

Water applications through DCED were discussed. This would be a multi-municipal involvement with Piatt Township. This will continue to be researched and look for funding for this project. There was some brief discussion with regards to the water, zoning and zoning upgrade for Woodward Township.

The area of Huling Road and Evergreen Road was discussed with regards to the runoff from that area of development. Will research the maps on this property.

There was some discussion with regards to the Township going out for quotes for insurance.

Joe showed pictures of the signage for the river lots on Dark Woods property. There would also be a sign as you entered the property with lot number and arrows points which lots are in what direction. The meeting continued after the Planning Commission meeting with Vic from Code Inspections, Inc. the discussion was regarding the building that was erected on the property at 4459 N Rt 220 Hwy. It was stated that the owner will be asked to get an engineer to assess the structure of the building and give the owner a list of items that will need to be taken care of to secure a building permit and occupancy permit for this structure. The zoning issue will be addressed first and then the land development portion.

The apartment on top of the garage on W. Emery Church Road was then discussed. This will be checked to see if anyone lives there first, then the other items can be addressed.

The meeting was adjourned.
